## RULES AND QUALIFICATIONS

1

### Options to earn an Alabama State Number & President Cup Qualifications

- A.** A Rider is considered fully Qualified with the *minimum* of **(6 Locals, 2 State Qualifiers, and 1 Double Points Race)** and races the **State Championship Race** will receive the following:
- An Alabama State Number of the riders earned ranking in age and class.
  - Will receive a 2010 Alabama State Plate.
  - Will receive a 2010 Alabama State Jersey
  - Will receive a 2010 Championship Trophy based on the riders performance at the race.
- B.** A Rider who fully qualifies with the *minimum* of **(6 Locals, 2 State Qualifiers, and 1 Double Points Race) ONLY**, and does not race the Championship will receive the following:
- An Alabama State Number of the riders earned ranking after any option "C" rider that races the State Championship.
  - Will receive a 2010 Alabama State Plate.
  - The rider would have to purchase 2010 Alabama State Jersey by September 25, 2010.
- C.** A Rider that races a **MINIMUM of (3 Locals & 1 State Qualifier)** will be considered a "minimum" Qualified rider and will receive the following:
- An Alabama State Number of the riders earned ranking in age and class.
  - The rider would have to purchase both 2010 Alabama State Plate & Jersey by September 25, 2010.
  - If this rider races the Championship, it would be as a **MINIMUM-QUALIFIED RIDER** and must meet the rules set forth in Section 2B for non-qualified and minimum qualified rider
- D. Qualifications to compete in the President Cup Race and represent the state of Alabama as a rider are as follows:**
- A Rider must meet at least the minimum qualifying option and RACE the ALABAMA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP RACE, to be eligible for the Presidents Cup Race.
  - A rider must finish in the Top 15 of his/her perspective class in the Alabama State Series
  - A rider, who wishes to participate in the President Cup Race, must wear the 2010 Alabama State Championship Jersey while competing at the event.

### State Championship Race

- A.** All qualified (Option "A") and minimum qualified (Option "C") riders will receive triple-points based on their performance in their perspective age and class. Any rider who races the Championship event in "class" will receive trophy of the day based on their performance. No Trophies for Open Class. All awards will be presented at the State Banquet.
- B.** Any **Non-Qualified Rider Or Min. Qualified Rider** wanting to race the Alabama State Championship must do the following:
- The Rider must be Pre-Register for the race by Deadline of September 13, 2010**
  - No state points will be awarded to NON-QUALIFIED riders.
  - Walk-ups the day of the Championship Race, see rule "2C"
- C.** **ALL NON-QUALIFIED and MINIMUM QUALIFIED Riders who are NOT PRE-REGISTERED by the deadline will only be allowed to race the Open Class at the championship event.**
- D.** Proficiency move up awards for Rookie and Novice riders will **NOT** be frozen

3	<p>A riders Total State Points for the 2010 Season will be based on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ (6) BEST Local's (Single Point Races)</li> <li>➤ (3) BEST Double points races, whether it be Qualifiers, Warnicke, or Double Point Event.</li> <li>➤ (1) State Championship Race (triple points).</li> </ul>
4	<p>Points from the Qualifiers and/or Double point's races <b>CANNOT</b> be exchanged / used as single point race.</p>
5	<p>Any Rider participating at any NBL National and/or Regional Events held in the state of Alabama from September 2009 to August 2010 will receive points toward the 2010 State Series. The races will be scored as a local (single point race). This will included the Friday Pre-Race, Day 1 and Day 2 races.</p>
6	<p><b>ALL races will be 3 Moto's, With MAINS, except as noted</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ A (2) Moto System will be used in the event of weather or other controlling factors. It is the Track Directors call whether a 2-Moto System will be used. See Section 7 for more details.</li> <li>➤ All Double-Header races will run 3-Moto System for 1<sup>st</sup> Race &amp; 2-Moto System for 2<sup>nd</sup>.</li> <li>➤ Up to 8 riders will transfer to a Main Event without dropping a rider.</li> <li>➤ Motos will be created using age then class as per the rules set forth in the NBL program.</li> </ul>
7	<p><b>In the event of a rainout or other race cancellation, the Track Directors options are as follows:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ One Complete round of Moto's, your finishes will be tripled or Reschedule race.</li> <li>➤ Two Complete rounds of Moto's, finishes will be based on 2-Moto Transfer System.</li> <li>➤ All main points will be awarded based on the riders overall Moto placement finish using the Olympic style system in the event race must be cancelled.</li> </ul>
8	<p><b>Phone Registration Rules:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. All tracks will be allowed to accept phone registration on the day of the event</li> <li>B. Rider's who phone register must give the following information:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. NBL Number, Plate number, and race type (trophy or points only)</li> <li>b. The name of the person calling to pre-register the rider</li> </ol> </li> <li>C. Any Phone / Pre-Registered Rider must check in with registration once they arrive at the track.</li> <li>D. It is the <b>RIDER'S responsibility</b> to inform the track clerk / registration, if they are unable to attend the race.</li> <li>E. Any rider, who is registered to race, must appear on the gate during the moto's at least one (1) time to get credit for race.</li> <li>F. Any Registered Rider who <u>DOES NOT Appear on gate during moto rounds at least once</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Will NOT get credit for the race</li> <li>b. Will NOT receive Points for the race</li> <li>c. Must pay the track the entry fee for the missed race, NO EXCEPTIONS</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
9	<p><b>Scoring</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ In scoring a <u>Mixed Class Moto's</u>. Riders will be scored as follows:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Moto Rounds will be scored separately by age &amp; class</li> <li>b. Main Events will be scored as they cross the finish line</li> <li>c. Trophies will be awarded separately by age &amp; class based on the Main results.</li> </ol> </li> <li>➤ Move-up points will be determined based on the finish line results of the Main Events.</li> <li>➤ In Moto's with or without a Main             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Any Rider that Did Not Start (DNS) will receive no points for that round</li> </ol> </li> <li>➤ If a class has a Main             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. 1<sup>st</sup> DNS = no points, but for transferring purposes only will be scored last +2</li> <li>b. 2<sup>nd</sup> or more DNS = no points &amp; cannot transfer to Main Event.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

Ranking:

- Your best 4 races in the series plus the 2009 Championship Race.

Points:

- Same as NBL national point program.

Awards:

- Overall winners will receive money based on attendance.
